#### **1. Pollinator Meadow**

---

**Wildlife and pollinator (bees and insects) habitat created where the area is now mowed.**  
The habitat would be tall grasses and flowering plants, with areas mowed on a three year rotating basis. The area is approximately 1.25 acres.

#### **2. Habitat Conversion**

---

**Convert the area adjacent to the community garden from mixed conifer to native shrubs.**  
The conifers are starting to shade out the community garden. Remove invasive trees such as cherry and English hawthorn, selectively cut conifers that are overcrowded or will shade out the community garden. Replant with diverse native trees and shrubs.
